

Dear Parents,

We would like to collect some loose parts, den poles and log rounds to develop outdoor play as part of Forest School sessions in the future at school. We are looking for the following items:



- Den poles 5-6 feet long including some y shape sticks (If you have Hazel trees these are ideal, and coppicing branches will not damage the tree at all, they will regrow very quickly!)
- Log rounds (for seating and for our tool area). Ideal rounds would be at least 25cm in diameter and the same in height. We need about 40 of these.

Also the following items that we call 'loose parts' for various team challenges, imaginary play and building:

- Crates –milk, bread, shopping crates
- Planks of wood
- Cable reels
- Pipes, guttering and tubes
- Tyres and steering wheels



We will be building a mud kitchen for the children to use, and would love to stock it with some kitchen items for their mud creations – to weigh, pour, scoop, mould, whisk and mash the mud!!



Useful items:
 Metal jugs, bowls,
 Balti dishes, pans,
 baking trays,
 teapots, cups,
 utensils, spoons,
 scales etc etc
